Lately we have received a lot of donations of books for the church library! I have been slowly working through the pile (not done yet) and decided it was time for a newsletter. So allow me to introduce you to some of the books I have added to the church library!

Every Good Endeavor by Tim Keller is a book on work. What is the purpose of work? How can I use my skills and abilities in work? How can I keep my moral standards in today's workplace? And is work just a drudgery or is it an act of worship before God? There's lots to think about for everyone!

The Passion of Jesus Christ by John Piper and **In the Presence of God** by R C Sproul are both devotional type books. The first on the reasons why Jesus came to die, the second on the attributes of God. Both excellent reads!

Boundaries Face to Face is a book helping people have hard conversations with those around them. At home, at work, at school, there is conflict in so many places. How can we have those hard conversations and do them well? A good book on the topic.

Wurmbrand the book and **Tortured for Christ** the DVD both tell the story of Pastor Richard Wurmbrand and his wife Sabina in Romania. Both were arrested for their faith, Richard was tortured and imprisoned for refusing to give up his faith to the communist regime, Sabina was put in a labor camp. Parents be sure to preview the movie before watching it with your children to be sure your kids can handle to story. A moving retelling of a story of faith and loving enemies in the harshest of circumstances.

Songs of Praise Volume Three joins the first two volumes already on the library shelf. These are easy arrangements of a selection of the songs in the Book of Praise, written for piano. Though these are found in the children's section, they are useful for anyone who wants to try an easy arrangement of some of the Psalms and Hymns.

The Sovereignty of God by A W Pink and **The Sovereignty of God** by John Murray are both classic books on the topic. They are both readable for everyone.

What is a Reformed Church by Stephen Smallman is part of the Basics of the Reformed Faith books. This short book goes through a quick history as well as a summary of the distinctives of a Reformed church. A great read.

Why Pro-Life? By Randy Alcorn is a good resource for conversations around abortion and unborn children. Answering a lot of the questions that are sure to come up as you talk about abortion and unborn children with your neighbors, this is a timely read for everyone.
